- Located on the 18th Green - Open Thursday- Sunday

HOSPITALITY TICKETS

- The Lemonade Stand
 - Located on the 18th Hole
 - Upgraded ticket venue with beautiful views of the closing par 5, 18th hole
 - Food and beverage available for purchase
 - Upgraded restrooms
- Corona Cabanas
 - Located along the 18th fairway with views of the 18th Green
 - Private space that includes 10x10 shaded area with soft seating and outdoor porch
 - Full lunch buffet, afternoon snacks, and full premium bar included
 - Complimentary parking

- o Upscale restrooms

HOSPITALITY HOURS OF OPERATION

- Thursday – Sunday
 - o Venues open at 8:00am & close 30 minutes after the last group is finished
 - o Lunch Service is available from 11:00am – 3:00pm (Corona Cabanas)
 - o Food Service is available from 11:00am – 6:00pm (The Lemonade Stand)
 - o Afternoon Snack service is available from 3:00pm – 6:00pm (Corona Cabanas)
 - o Bar Service is available from 9:00am – 6:00pm (The Lemonade Stand & Corona Cabanas)

VENUE ENTRY

- All patrons entering The Lemonade Stand or Corona Cabanas will have their tickets scanned TWICE
 - o First Ticket Scan – Takes place at the Main Entrance
 - o Second Ticket Scan – Takes place at the hospitality venue entrance
- Wristbands will be provided upon entry to the hospitality venue after the ticket has been scanned and approved
- Guests are allowed to come and go from the hospitality venue once the wristband has been received – Please note that the wristband must be shown to gain entry back into the hospitality venue
- If the wristband is removed, it will be considered invalid and cannot be replaced
- Hospitality Venue Youth Policy – All guests entering in hospitality venues must have a proper ticket unless they are under 10 years of age

ALL HOSPITALITY UNITS

- There will be dedicated volunteers assigned to all hospitality venues. Volunteers will be responsible for the general operations of the hospitality area and will check the venues on a regular basis each day to ensure you are satisfied. If issues arise, these volunteers will be your first resource for resolving the situation.
- Volunteers will help provide the following services to Hospitality Patrons:
 - o Control access into the designated hospitality area

- Assist in general hosting services
- Answer general event questions

PARKING

- Free parking is available for general spectators on the top deck of the South Parking Deck of the Glen Tower Center. The lot is accessible on Aviator Lane west of Tower Drive. Due to “Art at The Glen” on Saturday, July 25 and Sunday, July 26, Aviator Lane will only be accessible from Patriot Blvd (Tower Drive will be closed).
- B lot (VIP Parking- Pass Required) is available on the top deck of the North Parking Deck of the Glen Town Center. The lot is accessible at the intersection of W. Lake Avenue and Valor Drive, directly to the east of the Glen Club entrance.

SECURITY

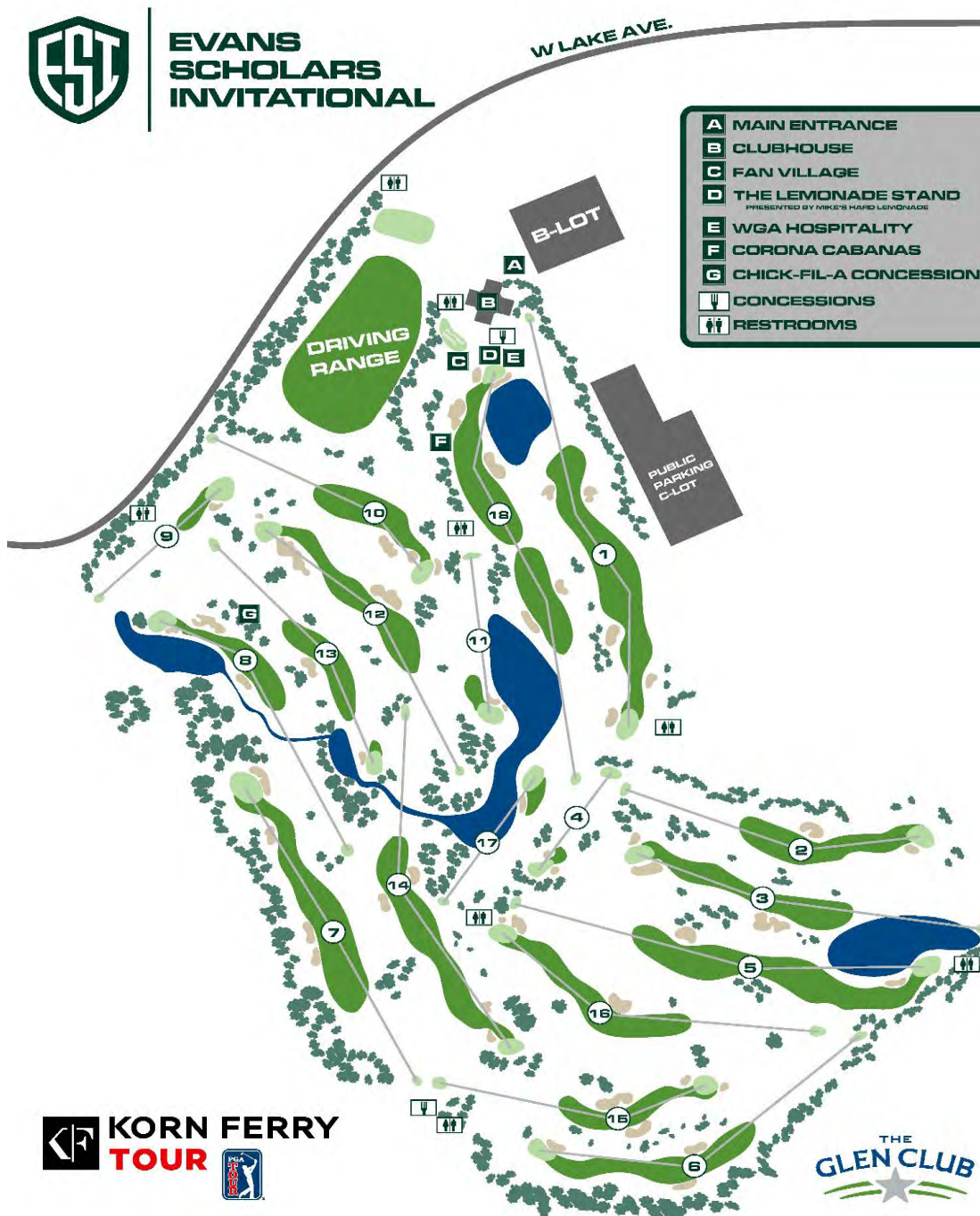
- Only those with a proper ticket, credential or wristband to gain access to the tournament grounds. We encourage you to remove any valuables from vehicles and/or hospitality units as the tournament will not be responsible for lost or stolen items.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQs)

- Autograph Policy
 - Autographs are permitted in the designated autograph zone behind the 18th green.
- Beverage Policy
 - No alcoholic beverages may be served or sold to anyone under the age of 21. We reserve the right to refuse alcohol service to anyone unable to provide proper identification to verify age or anyone who appears intoxicated.
- Disability Services
 - If you need additional assistance accessing the tournament grounds, please contact the Tournament Office at esinvite@wgaesf.org.
- Dress Code

- It is suggested that guests dress comfortably for the conditions and the weather. Golf course casual is acceptable
 - Denim and t-shirts are discouraged
- First Aid Stations
 - The Glenview Fire Department will have EMTs and an ambulance on-site while gates are open.
 - In case of emergency, locate the nearest person with a radio or call 911
- Lost & Found
 - All lost and found items will be turned into the Tournament Office located inside the Clubhouse
 - Items found on property will be turned into the Tournament Office at the end of each day
 - The Glen Club, the Korn Ferry Tour and the Evans Scholars Invitational are not responsible for any lost or stolen items
- Concession Locations
 - Concessions will be located between the 18th Green and the Clubhouse, between the 8th and 13th holes, and at the halfway house near 6 Green/ 7 Tee / 15 Tee
 - Concession stands and beverage carts will be open from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. daily.
 - Chick-fil-A will be set up between the 8th and 13th holes
- Restrooms
 - Near Putting Green
 - 1st Green
 - 3rd Tee
 - Halfway House
 - 9th Green
 - 16th Green
 - 18th Fairway
 - *There will be no Clubhouse access for restroom use*
- Merchandise
 - The pro-shop will be open to the public when gates are open.
- No Cash
 - The Evans Scholars Invitational is a cashless event, credit cards only
- Will Call
 - There will be no Will Call at the Evans Scholars Invitational
 - All tickets are mobile and can be shared via email
 - All tickets are digital and will be scanned upon entry
- Mobile Phone Policy
 - Fans are allowed to take photos all week on their mobile devices throughout the golf course, except in areas of competition during official rounds or when requested by players, security, or Korn Ferry Tour officials to refrain from taking a photo
 - Receiving or placing phone calls will remain limited to areas outside of play
 - Devices must be on silent at all times; flash may not be used

- o Devices may be used to capture video, audio and photos (content) in all areas throughout tournament week
- o Content may be used for personal purposes (e.g., personal social media); no commercial use
- o No live streaming or real-time coverage (e.g., no shot-by-shot coverage)
- o Data use (e.g., texting) is permitted in all areas throughout tournament week
- o Phone calls are allowed only in designated areas
- o Please be respectful of play and do not interfere with players, caddies or media
- o All posted signage and instructions from tournament staff must be observed
- o Failure to comply with this policy may result in the revocation of your ticket



WEATHER WARNING

“Weather Warning” alerts will be on all scoreboards when inclement weather is detected within a dangerous range. The intent behind these alerts is to notify fans of potentially dangerous weather before play is suspended to give fans time to move back to their vehicles. All fans should take cover immediately once the “Weather Warning” alerts have been posted. Suspension of play occurs with one prolonged blast of an air horn, repeated once. All fans should take cover immediately. Resumption of play occurs with two short blasts of an air horn, repeated once. Suspension of play is a stoppage of play, not necessarily a cancellation of play for the day.

SECURITY & PROHIBITED ITEMS

The Evans Scholars Invitational will ensure the safety of our spectators, players, volunteers, and guests by taking various security measures. Any other items deemed unlawful or dangerous by the Tournament Security Personnel is their sole discretion. Parents with small children are allowed to bring strollers and diaper bags if needed. These items are subject to reasonable inspection before entering and/or at any time during the tournament.

PROHIBITED ITEMS

	No bags larger than a small purse 6"x6" including carrying cases, backpacks, camera bags, or chair bags (See the PGA TOUR Bag Policy for more information (https://www.pgatour.com/company/tournaments-prohibited-items.html#bagpolicy))
	No clear plastic, vinyl, or other carry items larger than 12"x6"x12" (See the PGA TOUR Bag Policy for more information (https://www.pgatour.com/company/tournaments-prohibited-items.html#bagpolicy))
	No glass cups or bottles of any kind except for medical or infant needs
	No memorabilia including pin flags, photos, trading cards, balls and other sports paraphernalia
	No computers or laptops
	No fireworks or laser pointers
	No lounge or over-sized chairs with extended foot rests
	No seat cushions in a carrying case or that have pockets or compartments
	No pets, except for service animals
	No knives, firearms or weapons of any nature
	No video cameras (All Week)
	No point and shoot, film or DSLR cameras (During Competition Rounds)
	No selfie sticks or hand-held camera stabilizers
	No beverages (patrons may not bring in or exit with beverages) or coolers.
	No radios, TVs, or portable speakers
	No posters, signs or banners
	No motorcycles, mopeds, tricycles, bicycles (whether or not motor-driven), skateboards, hoverboards, or other similar devices will be permitted to be operated on or within tournament property. Segways®, motorized scooters or other personal transportation devices are prohibited if not used as a mobility aid by individuals with mobility impairment
	No drones, Remote Controlled Model Aircrafts or other devices that can be operated in airspace will be permitted to be operated at PGA TOUR events during tournament week.

PERMITTED ITEMS



Personal bags 6" x 6" or smaller



Clear plastic, vinyl or other carry items not exceeding 12" x 6" x 12"



A one-gallon clear resealable plastic bag



At the tournament's discretion, food may enter the tournament in a clear, resealable plastic bag, not to exceed the size of a one (1) gallon bag



Reusable plastic or metal cups/bottles that are empty upon entry and exit, and cannot hold more than 32-ounces



Mobile phones, tablets, and PDA's - **MUST** be on Silent mode and adhere to TOUR's Mobile Device Policy



Point and shoot, film or DSLR cameras with lens smaller than 6"; no case (During Practice Rounds Only)



Umbrellas without sleeve



Portable radios with headsets



Medically necessary materials, strollers, small diaper bags, plastic baby bottles, and other essential baby supplies (infant must be with carrier) - items subject to search



Collapsible chairs without chair bags



Binoculars without case



Seat cushions that do not require a carrying case or that do not have pockets or compartments



Segways®, motorized scooters or other personal transportation devices when used as a mobility aid by individuals with mobility impairment
